Intermittent Lane Closures on Kismet Parkway West of Del Prado Boulevard

Cape Coral, May 25, 2007 – As part of the Phase II Mainline Bridge Improvement Project on Del Prado Boulevard over Jaguar Canal to Kismet Parkway, motorists should be on alert for intermittent lane closures. Starting Tuesday, May 29th through Monday, June 18th crews will intermittently close down travel lanes on Kismet Parkway west of Del Prado Boulevard between the hours of 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. for paving and drainage structure installation work.

Advance warning signs, electronic message boards, and barricades will be used to assist motorists traveling through the area. Construction on this section of roadway is scheduled for approximately the next several months.

While traveling through the work zone, motorists are urged to use caution, obey the posted speed limit of 35 mph, and seek alternative routes whenever possible. Ongoing utility relocation work at times will affect driveways and side streets. Please be advised that unforeseen circumstances such as weather may affect the schedule.
